

## SUGGESTIONS

The Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs calls on the Committee on Budgetary Control, as the committee responsible, to incorporate the following suggestions in its motion for a resolution:

- 1. Is pleased to note that the Court of Auditors has been able to obtain a reasonable assurance that the annual accounts for the financial year ended 31 December 2005 are reliable and that the underlying transactions, taken as a whole, are legal and regular;
- 2. Regrets the Court of Auditors' finding of a number of anomalies in the procurement and contracting procedures; welcomes the steps taken by the European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction to improve its procedures;
- 3. Deplores the mismanagement found by the Court of Auditors with regard to the member of staff sent on a long-term mission to Brussels without a clear definition of its purpose and then their secondment to the Commission; asks the European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction and the Commission to investigate the case and to take measures to avoid a recurrence of such a case in the future;
- 4. Calls on the European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction to continue its efforts to improve its financial management.
