Coordinators informed that the Industry Committee had decided to request authorisation to draw up an own initiative report, and had suggested that the ENVI committee provide them with an opinion and help in the organisation of a joint meeting with national parliaments on the issue of energy efficiency.

- i. Ask to draw up an opinion (but decision on nomination of a draftsman postponed).
 - ii. Name a couple of members from the committee to help in the preparation of the meeting with the national parliaments (on the model followed for the preparation of the CARS 21 hearing).

4. Other nominations of rapporteurs

4.1 Other thematic strategies

- i. Marine environment strategy (expected second half of October: will include legislative proposal)
- ii. Thematic strategy on the prevention and recycling of waste (expected second half of November: will include legislative proposal)
- iii. Thematic strategy on the sustainable use of natural resources (expected second half of November: currently not planned to include legislative proposal)
- iv. Soil strategy (expected first half December: planned to include legislative proposal)
- v. Urban environment strategy (expected in December: currently not planned to include legislative proposal)
- vi. Pesticides strategy (expected in January of February 2006: planned to include legislative proposal)

Decision: Appoint rapporteurs on all these thematic strategies as part of a package of nominations (and check their status and timing)

4.2 Own initiative report on natural disasters (fires and floods)

Coordinators informed that the three concerned chairmen had now met and had reached the following agreement:

- i. to draw up three separate reports, within each committee's area of competence, but with close coordination between the three committees, and with the reports not coming out of the committees quota of own initiative reports. These reports would be presented to the plenary in the late spring of 2006;
- ii. to send three delegations to the most affected areas, each delegation consisting of 10 members, with the 30 available places being equally divided between the three committees:
 - delegation to Portugal and Spain (to look into fires and drought, to be chaired by REGI,
 - delegation to Austria and Germany (problems posed by floods, to be chaired by ENVI),
 - delegation to France and Italy (droughts and floods, to be chaired by AGRI);

iii. to hold a joint hearing in Brussels with Presidency and Commission representatives as well as national and other experts (around 10 in all). This hearing would probably be held in February 2006.

- Decisions:**
- i. Appoint a rapporteur for the report within ENVI area of competence.
 - ii. Coordinators requested to select 10 members from the committee to take part in the delegations and to help the rapporteur in organising the programme for the delegations and the structure of the hearing.

5. OTHER ISSUES TO BE CONSIDERED

5.1 Delegation visits in 2006

Coordinators informed that the committee had been asked to respond to the Conference of Committee chairmen by 7 November, so that the necessary authorisations could be granted first by them, and then by the Bureau before the end of the year.

Decision: Coordinators agreed that there should be delegations to Croatia and to Turkey and another one to look at the implementation of EU law in a Member State where problems had emerged (but final decisions postponed to next meeting).

5.2 Implementation sessions in the areas of health and of food safety

Decision: Coordinators supported the idea of introducing additional question times on food safety (possibly early in 2006) and health legislation (later on in 2006)

5.3 Council of Europe Conference on Water Management: A Shared Responsibility

Coordinators informed that the Environment Committee of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe has invited interested members to attend the conference that they are holding on the above subject in Strasbourg on 20-21 October.

Coordinators requested to inform the secretariat whether any of their members wish to attend.

5.4 International Energy Efficiency Conference in London on 2-3 November 2005: possible participation of ENVI members

Coordinators informed that the committee had been invited by the British Presidency (along with the ITRE Committee) to nominate 5 of our members to a conference being held by the Presidency at the Barbican in London on 2-3 November 2005, which, inter alia, would be looking at ways of reducing greenhouse gas emissions.

Coordinators requested to inform the secretariat whether any of their

members wish to attend.

5.5 Future working methods in the Committee (handling of Commission proposals and impact statements, voting times in committee, etc, time left for Commission at end of debate)

It has previously been suggested that the coordinators discuss some of the issues related to the working methods of the committee. Three such questions are raised below.

i. Handling of Commission proposals within the Committee

Once rapporteurs have been appointed there is a general tendency to concentrate on specific amendments on the details of the proposal rather than first hold more general orientation debates on the proposal as a whole, and on the quality and conclusions of any accompanying impact statement.

Are the coordinators satisfied with existing practice or would they support a change on the above lines, which might imply a longer initial phase of general debate than at present, and much more detailed examination of any Commission impact assessments? Moreover, should the responsible Commissioner be asked to introduce any major new Commission initiative directly to the Committee?

ii. Discussion of Commission Activity Reports

Each Commission Directorate-General (in our case the relevant ones are DG Environment, DG SANCO and DG Enterprise) produces annual activity reports, normally in September, which examine their performance during the year, and how they have met their objectives. Unlike the Annual Legislative Programme these have not been subject to specific debate within our Committee.

Would it be a good idea to debate these within the Committee, possibly on the basis of an introduction from the Director-General concerned?

iii. Fixed voting times in Committee

It has been suggested by some members that the introduction of fixed voting times within the Committee would help members. On the other hand, such fixed voting times might also lead to debates being interrupted, to gaps within committee agendas, and to greater inflexibility in the handling of committee business. Committees which have introduced such a practice of fixed voting time normally have considerably fewer votes than ENVI. Finally, our Committee has already made a step in this direction, not only by concentrating votes on the second morning of the meeting, but by introducing indicative timing for each point on the agenda.
