***Antonio Milošoski** (born January 29, 1976 in Tetovo, Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, now Republic of Macedonia) is a Macedonian politician and current minister of foreign affairs of the Republic of Macedonia.*

In 1999, Milošoski graduated from the Faculty of Law in Ss. Cyril and Methodius University of Skopje. In 2002, he studied postgraduate studies at the University of Bonn, Germany, and became a graduate of Master of European Integration. He is foreign minister since 26 August, 2006 and has knowledge of four foreign languages - English, German, Serbian and Croatian.
