Daniela Viglione is President and CEO of Italian news agency AGI-Agenzia Giornalistica Italia since 2006. She is member of the Board of Eni's research foundation FEEM-Fondazione Eni Enrico Mattei, member of the Regional Council of Italy's Environment Fund FAI-Fondo Italiano per l'Ambiente, member of Fondazione Bellisario in support of women entrepreneurship, and member of the Jury of Premio Minerva that is awarded to women that work in the field of knowledge.

From 2005 to February 2011 Daniela was the first woman President of the National Press

Agencies of the Italian Federation of Newspaper Publishers (FIEG).

In 2009 she was appointed "commendatore della Repubblica" (commander of the Italian order of chivalry) by President of the Italian Republic Giorgio Napolitano.

Daniela holds a degree in Economic History at La Sapienza University in Rome. She has worked as an economist and manager at Montedison, Finmeccanica and Eni where she has been head of the Economic and Energy Study and Research Department, head of External Relations, head of the Coordination of Economic and Social Analysis and Cultural Policies, and CEO of EniComunicazione SpA, the ENI subsidiary entrusted with the planning and creation of communications products, services and events.

Daniela collaborated with economic independent research centers and governmental committees in the fields of development policies, industrial and social equality and was member of the first Commissions on Poverty, Equal Opportunities, Reform of Welfare State.
