He is a Jean Monnet Professor of Political Science and Chair of the Board of the Institute of International Affairs and Centre for Small State Studies at the University of Iceland. His research focus is particularly small-state studies, European integration and Iceland's foreign policy. He has published a number of articles on small states in Europe, European integration and Iceland's foreign policy. He has written two books on small states in Europe, i.e. 'Iceland and European integration: On the Edge' (Routledge 2004) and 'The Role of Small States in the European Union' (Ashgate 2000). He teaches in the Faculty of Political Science at the University of Iceland. He received his Ph.D. in Political Science from the University of Essex in UK in 1999.

In 2002, Baldur established a Centre for Small State Studies at the University of Iceland in association with colleagues around the globe. The aim of the Centre is to enhance small state studies by research, teaching and by carrying out service projects for the public and private sector.
