Regulation 1927/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 December 2006, as amended by Regulation (EC) 546/2009, establishes the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (EGF).

Point 28 of the Inter-institutional Agreement between the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission of 17 May 2006 on budgetary discipline and sound financial management sets the budgetary framework.

The total annual budget available for EGF is EUR 500 million. Article 8(1) of Regulation (EC) 1927/2006 states that 0.35% of this amount (i.e. EUR 1 750 000) can be made available each year for technical assistance at the initiative of the Commission.

d) Detailed grounds for the increase

An amount of EUR 1 120 000 is requested in order to cover technical assistance related to the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund.

The objective of the technical assistance is to finance monitoring, information and advice to Member States on using, following up and evaluating EGF.

The measures to be supported with the requested appropriations are:

- Data collection, update and print of the Statistical Portrait of the EGF a publication presenting ٠ information and statistical data on EGF.
- Updates and expanding of the EGF website http://ec.europa.eu/egf including translation of new • elements into all EU languages. Printing of the information folders; production, translation, printing and distribution of an annual report. EGF is also to be covered in various Commission publications and audio-visual activities.

- Continuation of work on setting up standardised procedures for EGF applications. This should allow for the simplification of future application, speeding up their processing and easier extraction of reports.
- Creating and rationalising a database containing the facts and figures of EGF cases (including workers, measures and outcomes).
- Data gathering on timelines of redundancies in the MS.
- Meetings of the Expert Group of Contact Persons of the EGF.
- Networking and knowledge sharing meetings (participants with experience in EGF implementation).
- Evaluation of the closed EGF cases with a focus on management systems, participants in the measures and outcomes. The first year of the evaluation is supposed to cover 32 cases.

The above-mentioned measures aim into facilitating of the application procedure as well as enabling better access to and easier proceeding of the relevant data.

Enhanced knowledge sharing, including via EGF website and publications as well as via experts group and networking combined with a better overview of the functioning of EGF thanks to the evaluation study should lead to more efficient implementation of EGF measures in the future.
