PEACE FOR ALL AFGHANS?

"An end to the fighting is the main aim of the Afghan people", was the message of Afghan President Karzai when addressing the High Peace Council of Afghanistan. After more than three decades of violent conflict, Afghans are longing for peace. With the current international military missions coming to an end by 2014, the context for the peace talks will be changing.

In order to achieve a sustainable peace, the process leading to it, has to be participatory and inclusive. The international conference "Peace for all Afghans?" wants to highlight the role of civil society in bringing the violent conflict to an end. Women activists, local peace-builders, politicians and experts gather to discuss how peace can be achieved.
