Statement by High Representative Catherine Ashton on agreement between the United States and Russia on a new strategic arms reduction treaty (START)

Catherine Ashton, the High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy and Vice-President of the Commission made the following statement:

"I warmly congratulate the United States and Russia for concluding the negotiations of the post-START treaty.

By reducing substantially the number of deployed strategic nuclear warheads and delivery system, by establishing a strong verification mechanism and setting the stage for further reductions, this treaty represent a remarkable progress in the fulfilment of the disarmament obligations of the parties. It enhances the security of the contracting parties and of the international community as a whole.

The conclusion of this treaty will send a strong positive signal to the Nuclear Proliferation Treaty Review Conference scheduled to take place in May in New York and will contribute to accelerate the global disarmament efforts."
