"The European Parliament's Delegation for Relations with the Korean Peninsula strongly condemns attack by the DPRK on a South Korean Island. These events are not conducive to peace and stability on the Korean Peninsula," stressed the Chairman of the European Parliament's Delegation for Relations with the Korean Peninsula, Christian Ehler (EPP, DE), in the wake of North Korean attack on South Korean Island.
