Dr. Nabeel Sha'ath, Born in Safad, Galilee, holds a Ph.D in Economics and Management Science and LL.D in Law from University of Pennsylvania; a Former Minister for Planning and International Cooperation (in 1994) and Minister of Foreign Affairs in PA n 2003 then the Prime Minister Deputy in 2005, a member of Higher Negotiation Committee attending Wye River, Camp David, Taba, Annapolis and other major Negotiations arenas. He was elected to the Palestinian Legislative Council in 1996 and Palestine National Council. In 1970, he occupied the position of Director General of the PLO Planning Center in Beirut and Chairman Arafat's Political Advisor (until 1977).

Dr. Sha'ath was Member of the Madrid delegation, and took leading role in Oslo process: held meeting with Yossi Sarid in July 1993 (the 1st meeting between a PLO leader and an authorized Israeli cabinet member) to agree the Gaza-Jericho formula; wrote a Palestinian draft DoP for the Oslo agreement. PLO's chief negotiator at Taba talks from October 1993. Heads the committee on national reconstruction, established after Mar-May 02 onslaught.

Dr. Sha'ath is Member of the Revolutionary Council of Fatah since 1971 and the Commissioner of International Relations of Fatah; he was the Chairman of Fatah National Congress over the years (1971-1989), He is the Head of the Political Committee of the General Congress of Fatah and editor of its Political Program. He was re-elected in 2009 to become a member of Fatah Central Committee.

Dr. Sha'ath is the Chairman of the Board of Trustees, Al-Azhar University since 2005, was the founder and president of Team International and Dar El-Fata Al-Arabi (The Arab World's only publishing House for Children).
