This PP is intended to increase the safety, health and well-being of older workers and will help alleviate the serious financial impact on workers, employers and taxpayers of the ageing workforce by:

- identifying and exchanging good practice and legal provisions in the Member States,
- implementing measures raising awareness for the special needs of the older workers, not only with regard to their physical and mental health but also with regard to adaptations of Human Resources Management and the Corporate Culture in enterprises,
- targeting younger workers preparing them for a longer working live,
- ensuring that existing legal requirements for the prevention of harm to workers are applied, where necessary specifically for older workers, for example, by the consideration of diversity in risk assessment,
- promoting the integration, or mainstreaming, of occupational safety and health into general employment policies in areas such as equality actions, retirement / pension options, human resources and training issues,
- ensuring the integration, or mainstreaming, of issues relating to the changing demographic structure of Europe's workforce into labour inspection activities and other prevention activities,
- taking into account the gender dimension with regard to changes in the age structure of the workforce, For example, relating to information provision on the impact of the menopause,
- enhancing developments in areas such as return-to-work and rehabilitation for older workers, for example, for where a worker has been out of the workforce as a result of an occupational musculoskeletal disorder.
