This new line shall be used for sustainable and innovative projects on local, regional and national level, which support young people leaving school at a young age without graduation and who do not have any chance to graduate in the future. The target group are young people who are not in education, neither in apprenticeship, nor employed.

Nevertheless these young people even have vocational skills and competencies. The first step to give them a chance to get into the labour market is to make them familiar with the needs of the companies. The challenge is to build up a network of companies which are open-minded and willing to create job opportunities for early school leavers. If companies, schools and youth welfare services work hand-in-hand to integrate early school leavers there is the possibility of matching them successfully. These cooperation projects will work in different ways depending on local circumstances. The different projects should be evaluated.

Justification:

15 % of young people are leaving school at a young age without graduation and do not have any chance to graduate. The target group are young people who are not in education, neither in apprenticeship, nor employed. Within the group of early school leavers the EU average rate is twice as high for migrant youth as for native youth. Whereas Europe is facing the demographic change and therefore a decreasing number of workforces, the support of every single person is important. The experience to be successful in life is the first step which encourages young people to get into the labour market.

This PP is intended to increase the safety, health and well-being of older workers and will help alleviate the serious financial impact on workers, employers and taxpayers of the ageing workforce by:

- identifying and exchanging good practice and legal provisions in the Member States,*
- implementing measures raising awareness for the special needs of the older workers, not only with regard to their physical and mental health but also with regard to adaptations of Human Resources Management and the Corporate Culture in enterprises,*
- targeting younger workers preparing them for a longer working live,*
- ensuring that existing legal requirements for the prevention of harm to workers are applied, where necessary specifically for older workers, for example, by the consideration of diversity in risk assessment,*
- promoting the integration, or mainstreaming, of occupational safety and health into general employment policies in areas such as equality actions, retirement / pension options, human resources and training issues,*
- ensuring the integration, or mainstreaming, of issues relating to the changing demographic structure of Europe's workforce into labour inspection activities and other prevention activities,*
- taking into account the gender dimension with regard to changes in the age structure of the workforce, For example, relating to information provision on the impact of the menopause,*
- enhancing developments in areas such as return-to-work and rehabilitation for older workers, for example, for where a worker has been out of the workforce as a result of an occupational musculoskeletal disorder.*

The PP will build on and enhance the recommendations of the study on New Forms of Physical and Psychosocial Health Risks at work commissioned by the EP (IP/A/EMPL/FWC/2006-205/C1-SC1) and of the EP resolution on the Community strategy 2007-2013 on Health and Safety at Work (P6_TA(2008)0009).
