Consolidated amendment replacing Amendments 6, 14, 18, 19, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38

### Proposal for a decision

#### Article 1

Directive 2003/87/EC

Article 10 – paragraph 4 – subparagraph 1 – last sentence

*Text proposed by the Commission*

The Commission **shall, where appropriate**, adapt the timetable for **each period** so as to ensure an orderly functioning of the market.

*Amendment*

The Commission **may, in exceptional circumstances**, adapt the timetable for **the period referred to in Article 13(1) beginning on 1 January 2013** so as to ensure an orderly functioning of the market **where an impact assessment shows that impact of such intervention on sectors exposed to a significant risk of carbon leakage is limited. The Commission shall make no more than one such adaptation.**

### Proposal for a decision

#### Recital 2

*Text proposed by the Commission*

(2) For the purposes of legal certainty and market predictability, it should be clarified that, in order to ensure an orderly functioning of the market, the Commission is able in exceptional circumstances to adapt the auction timetable pursuant to Article 10(4) of Directive 2003/87/EC.

(2) For the purposes of legal certainty and market predictability, it should be clarified that, in order to ensure an orderly functioning of the market, the Commission is able in exceptional circumstances to adapt the auction timetable pursuant to Article 10(4) of Directive 2003/87/EC **provided that such intervention can be justified by an impact assessment showing that impact on sectors exposed to a significant risk of carbon leakage is limited. The Commission should be able**

adaptation and only during the eight-year  
period beginning on 1 January 2013.*
