## C. DECISIONS ON OTHER ISSUES

## C.1. Hearing of the Executive Director-designate of the EMA, Prof. Guido RASI

## Decision:

The coordinators approved the following arrangements, which are based on Article 64 of the founding Regulation of the European Medicines Agency, Parliament's internal rules and the practice established at the occasion of similar hearings of new Agency Executive Directors:

- The hearing is scheduled for 13 July 2011, starting at 15.00 hrs.
- The net duration of the hearing shall be 2 hrs , with questions to be asked and answered in the "ping-pong" format (question - answer - additional question
- supplementary answer). The number of questions will be allotted to the groups according to their relative strength in the ENVI committee. A separate hearing desk shall be installed (as was the case for Ms Geslain-Lanéelle). The hearing is expected to end at $+/-\mathbf{1 7 . 1 5} \mathbf{~ h r s}$.
- The coordinators would meet after the hearing, at +/- $\mathbf{1 7 . 3 0} \mathbf{~ h r s}$ for their evaluation session (in camera).
- In line with the applicable Rules, the draft evaluation letter would be circulated for comments, and the signed letter subsequently be sent to the President of the European Parliament, who would submit it to the Conference of Presidents for its final decision. The President of the European Parliament would then inform the Agency of the Parliament's position.
- The chairman will inform the Executive Director-designate, the chairman of the EMA Management Board and the acting Executive Director of the above arrangements in writing.


## C.2. The case of Mr Holoman, substitute Member of the EMA Management Board

This item was postponed, in order to deal with it in the presence of Ms Roth-Behrendt at a future coordinators' meeting.

## C.3. Attendance at committee hearings

## Decision

The coordinators were invited to encourage MEPs to attend the hearing on the Baltic Sea scheduled for 21 June p.m.

They agreed furthermore that the groups would endeavour to ensure the following minimum levels of attendance: 3 MEPs for the large two groups, 2 MEPs for the following three groups, 1 Member for the remaining groups (i.e. 14 MEPs in total).

## C.4. Emissions from aviation and maritime transport

## Decision

The coordinators decided to invite the Commission to the committee for a presentation of the situation and the EU activities in these areas.

## C.5. Malnourished patients

The papers for the meeting included a draft oral question on malnutrition (tabled by Mr Alojz Peterle) as well as position by the European Nutrition for Health Alliance (ENHA) on Routine Nutritional Status and Risk Screening across Europe

## Decision

The coordinators instructed the secretariat to enquire whether any EU powers and responsibilities existed in relation to the issues raised in the draft oral question and whether the Commission had deployed any relevant activities in this field.

- agreed to return to the possibility to draw up a legislative own-initiative should the replies received from the Commission be unsatisfactory.

The coordinators decided that an Oral Question (in plenary) plus resolution be prepared ahead of the Council's decision (scheduled for 10 October 2011) determining the EU position for the Rio+20 Conference, with a view to dealing with the Oral Question (and the winding-up resolution) in the September II plenary session.
