# **NOTICE TO MEMBERS**

Subject: Petition 0090/2010 by Dieter Schlemann (German), on on behalf of 'LTB

Schlemann GmbH', protesting against the European Aviation Safety Agency

(EASA) proposal for Airworthiness Directive PAD 10-010

## 1. Summary of petition

The petitioner protests at the EASA's proposal for Airworthiness Directive PAD 10-010, which requires aircraft supplied by certain German firms, including LTB Schlemann, to be replaced. The reason given by the EASA is that the firms in question do not meet the requirement of possessing approved maintenance data. The petitioner considers PAD 10-010 incompatible with the provisions of Commission Regulation (EC) No 2042/2003 on the continuing airworthiness of aircraft and aeronautical products, parts and appliances, and on the approval of organisations and personnel involved in these tasks, since the Regulation states that overhaul and maintenance are to take place in accordance with national legislation. The petitioner also refers to the European Parliament resolution of 3 February 2009 on an Agenda for Sustainable Future in General and Business Aviation (P6\_TA(2009)0036), and therefore calls on the European Parliament to ensure that EASA withdraws airworthiness directive PAD 10-010, and that account is taken of the recommendations in Parliament's above-mentioned resolution.

### 2. Admissibility

Declared admissible on 30 April 2010. Information requested from Commission under Rule 202(6).

**3.** Commission reply, received on 24 June 2010.

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The Legislator has elected to give exclusive competence to the European Aviation Safety Agency for the issuance of Airworthiness Directives, pursuant to point (1)(j) of Article 20 of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008. The Commission therefore forwarded the petition to EASA.

In its response of 21<sup>st</sup> May 2010 (see attached), EASA stated that on 12 April 2010 it had decided to withdraw its Proposed Airworthiness Directive PAD 10-010.

Dear Mr Calleia.

This letter is in reply to the Commission's information request on the petition of reference whereby the petitioner, Mr Schlemann on behalf of LTB Schlemann GmbH, protested at the EASA's notification of a proposal to issue an Airworthiness Directive (PAD No. 10-010). Furthermore, the petitioner called on the European Parliament to ensure that EASA withdraws this PAD.

First of all, we would like to mention that by issuing the PAD of reference the Agency has followed its standard procedures in this regard and accordingly submitted the scope of the PAD No. 10-010 to the stakeholders for comments. The PAD as such does not constitute any binding decision of the Agency. This means that the intended addressees were not obliged to comply with it and it did not create any kind of obligations for other affected parties.

Having said that, we would like to inform you that PAD No 10-010 has been withdrawn through the PAD 10-010 Withdrawal Statement from 12.4.2010 (attached). We understand that the withdrawal of the PAD of reference satisfies the request of the petitioner.

wir möchten mit diesem Schreiben auf die Informationsanfrage der Europäischen Kommission zu der oben genannten Petition antworten. Der Beschwerdeführer, Herr Schlemann, protestiert mit dieser Petition im Namen der LTB Schlemann GmbH gegen die Bekanntgabe des Vorschlags der EASA, eine Lufttüchtigkeitsanweisung (PAD No 10-010) erlassen zu wollen. Der Beschwerdeführer ersucht das Europäische Parlament weiterhin sicherzustellen, dass EASA den Vorschlag PAD 10-10 zurücknimmt.

Zunächst möchten wir darauf hinweisen, dass die Bekanntgabe des Vorschlags nach den anwendbaren Verfahrensvorschriften erfolgt ist. Demnach wirde mit dem PAD zunächst der heabsichtide Readlungsbereich für eine Lufttüchtigkeitsanweisung mitgeteilt und den Interessierten Kreisen die Möglichkeit gegeben, hierzu Kommentare abzugeben. Das PAD stellt als solches noch keine bindende Entscheidung der Agentur dar. Der angesprochene Adressatenkreis ist nicht verpflichtet das PAD zu befolgen. Auch begründet das PAD keine Verpflichtungen für die betroffenen Personen.
Weiterhin möchten wir Sie darüber informieren, dass das PAD 10-010 durch die PAD 10-010 Rücknahmemitteilung vom 12.4.2010 (siehe Anlage) zurückgenommen worden ist. Wir gehen davon aus, dass die Rücknahme dem Begehren des Beschwerdeführers entspricht.
