

**Petition 1764/2008 by David Pegg (British), on behalf of the EU Trade Group of the Palestinian Solidarity Campaign, on banning all EU imports of products from the Israeli settlements in the Occupied Palestinian Territories**

The petitioner asks the European Parliament to request the Council and the Commission to ban all EU imports of products from the Israeli settlements in the Occupied Palestinian Territories until the legitimate rights of the Palestinian people are restored. According to the petitioner such measure is justified by repeated violation of international humanitarian law by Israel. The petitioner dismisses the argument according to which Palestinians working on the settlements would also be harmed by the ban, explaining that there are very few Palestinian workers partly due to their replacement by migrant workers and partly due to restrictions imposed upon Palestinian movement.
