Your note dated 12 July 2010, concerning petition 0026/2010 by Peter Schönberger (German), on the award of merit points and the

European Ombudsman's decision on complaint 344/2007(WP)BEH.

By letter of 12 July 2010, you requested further information on the action taken to follow up on the Ombudsman's critical remarks:

"It is good administrative practice for an Appointing Authority to conduct the procedure leading to the award of merit points in line with the applicable rules. This includes carrying out a proper comparative assessment of the merits of its staff members. In the present case, Parliament failed to conduct such an assessment. This constitutes maladministration".

Following these critical remarks, the competent Appointing Authority has proceeded to a new thorough examination of the complainant's file.

In this view, with respect to rules and procedures governing the assessment of the merits of officials, a new comparative assessment of M. Schönberger's merits and those of the officials of the same grade, working for the same Directorate-General, has been carried out, duly taking into account the Ombudsman's recommendation.

In this context, it should be noted that this assessment has confirmed the attribution of two merit points to M. Schönberger for 2004.
