

Petition 0026/2010 by Peter Schönberger (German), on the award of merit points and the European Ombudsman's decision on complaint 344/2007(WP)BEH

The petitioner refers to the European Ombudsman's decision of 22 December 2009 on the above-mentioned complaint concerning the award of merit points at the European Parliament. The European Ombudsman concluded his investigation with some critical remarks in which he stressed that the European Parliament had not carried out a comparative assessment of the petitioner's merits in 2004, and that the principle of good administrative behaviour had therefore not been complied with. The petitioner therefore asks the Committee on Petitions to ensure that action is taken to follow up the Ombudsman's critical comments, and that consideration of the petitioner's merit points for 2004 is resumed.

Recommendations

- Declare admissible;
- Forward to the European Parliament's Directorate-General for Personnel for its opinion.
