As of 2007, the assistance continues through the Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance (IPA)






IPA I (2007-2013) €1.4 billion

- Institution building
- Cross-border cooperation
- ► Support to preparation of programming of using and development of a system for management and quality use of EU funds following the accession
- ► Regional cooperation



IPA II (2014 - 2020) €1.5 billion

- Support to reform adoption and implementation
- ► Gradually aligning with EU standards in order to achieve full-fledged membership
