
Legal mission of the Combat Poverty Agency:

- Representation of poor people in statistics
- Accent on economical growth at the expense of social improvement

 - Integreted targets

Priorities:

- Quality jobs accessible for those who are the furthest from the labour market
- Education/training
- Social protection
- Participation
