## **NOTICE TO MEMBERS**

Subject: **Petition 1711/2013 by Rolandos Ioannou (Cypriot) on infringements of the TFEU by the Republic of Cyprus**

### **1. Summary of petition**

The petitioner maintains that the Cyprus authorities are failing to implement primary and secondary EU law and that the EU is taking no action to remedy matters. By way of example he refers to the national telecommunications and ports authorities, alleging that he himself has uncovered widespread corruption. He maintains that no action was taken and that he was the only person to suffer any consequences, since he and his large household have been left in serious financial difficulties as a result.

### **2. Admissibility**

Declared admissible on 13 June 2014. Information requested from Commission under Rule 216(6).

### **3. Commission reply, received on 29 September 2014**

With regard to this submission, the Petitions committee requested information from the Commission regarding EU-funded projects.

The Commission would like to inform the Petitions committee that no link could be established with ERDF/CF co-financed actions, as no element referred to in the petition concerns an ERDF/CF co-financed project.
