² Any regular income Members receive in respect of each item declared shall be placed in one of the following categories:

1. EUR 500 to EUR 1000 gross a month;
2. EUR 1001 to EUR 5000 gross a month;
3. EUR 5001 to EUR 10 000 gross a month;
4. more than EUR 10 000 gross a month.

Incomes in a currency other than Euro shall be converted and declared in Euros, using the exchange rate applicable on the date when the Declaration is submitted. Any other income Members receive in respect of each item declared shall be calculated on an annual basis, divided by twelve and placed in one of the above categories. If the amount of the regular or other income is below the threshold of category 1, i.e. below 500 EUR gross per month, or if the declared occupation, membership, activity, holding or partnership is not remunerated, a category does not need to be indicated.
