The text constitutes an official codification (6) of that Directive without making substantive changes. ENTRY INTO FORCE: 11 April 2001. It should be noted that the deadline for the transposition of Directive

98/50/EC amending Directive 77/187/EEC stands. The Member States, therefore, have until 17 July 2001 to comply with the provisions of Directive 98/50/EC.?
