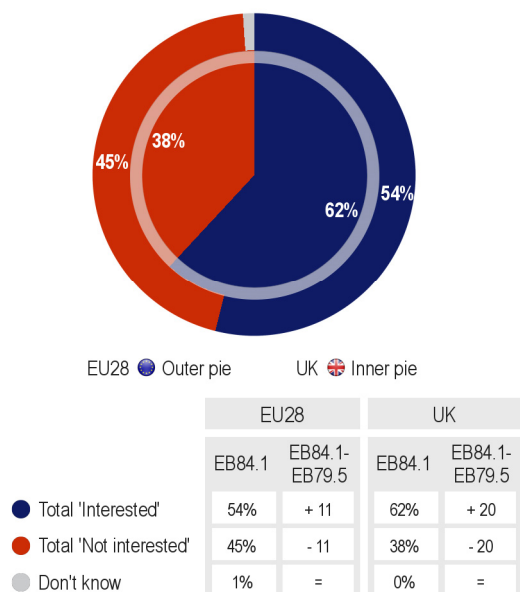

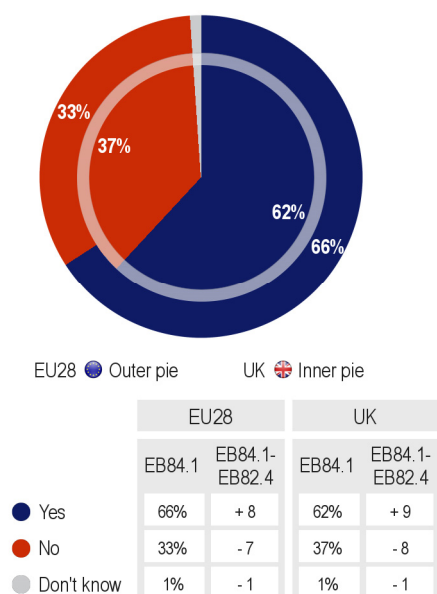

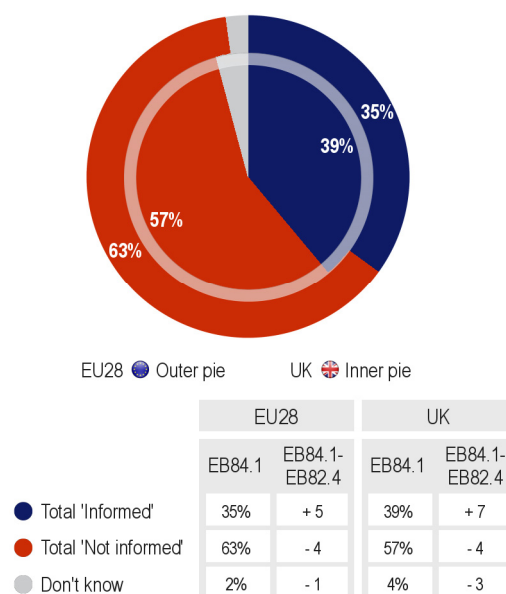

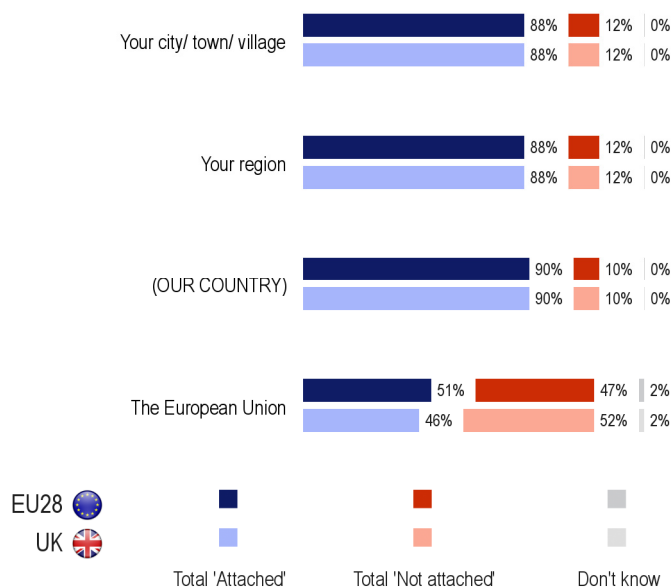

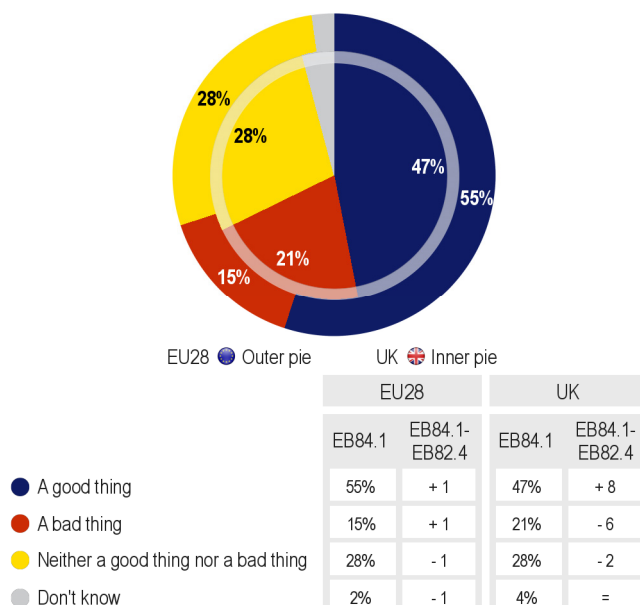

Q20. Generally speaking, do you think that (OUR COUNTRY)'s membership of the EU is...?

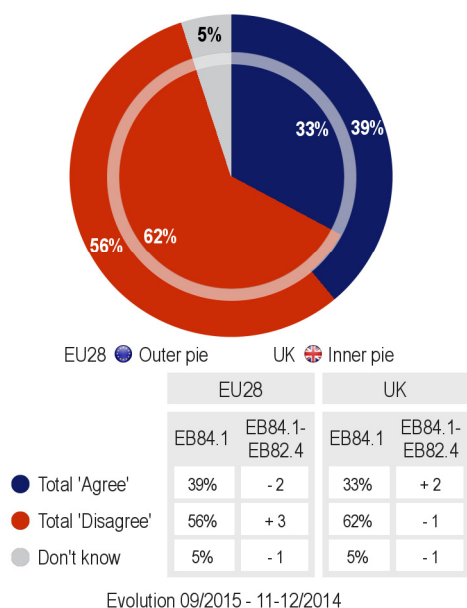

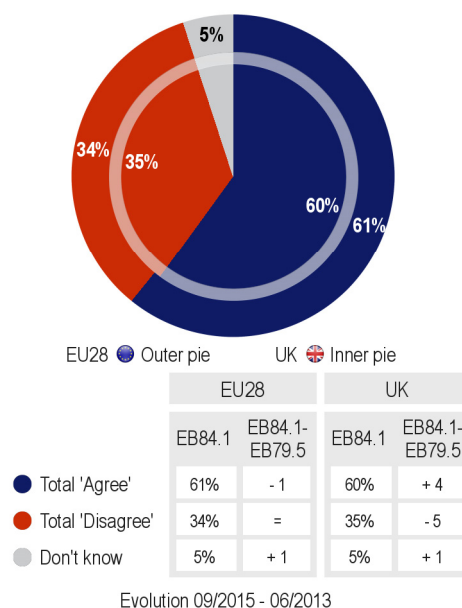
My voice counts in the EU

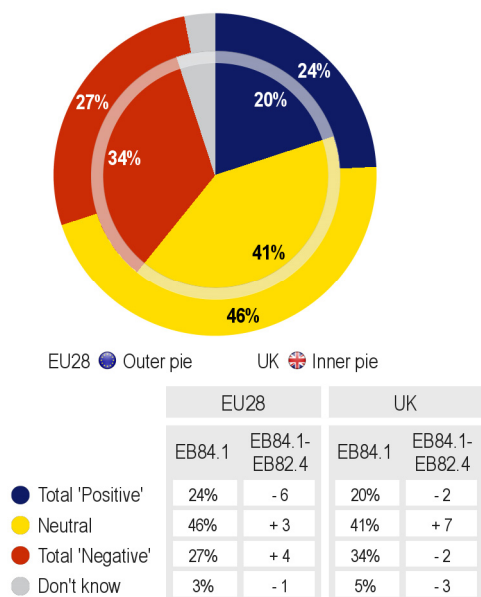

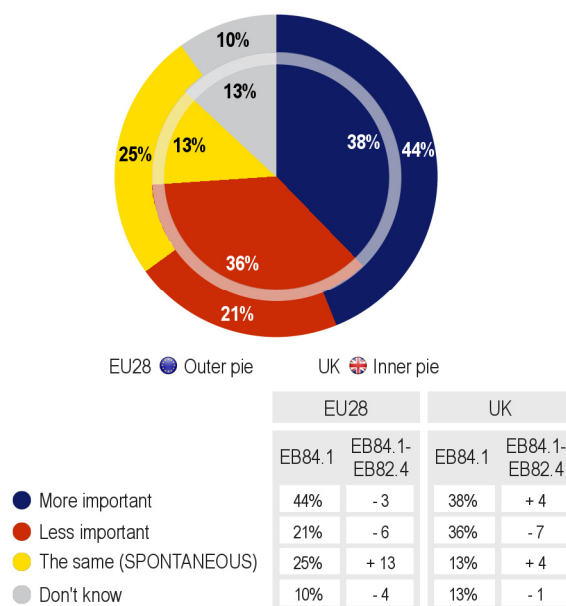

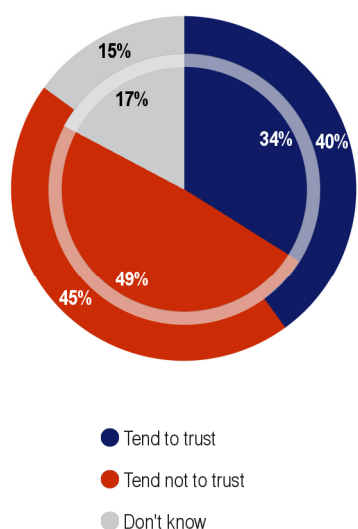
Q7. Would you personally like to see the European Parliament play a more important or less important role than it currently does?
