Opening — West Bank settlements added to Middle East debate

The title of a statement by EU foreign policy chief Federica Mogherini on prospects for resuming Middle East peace talks will be changed to "Situation in the West Bank, in particular settlements". An oral question on Germany's revised road toll plan was moved from Thursday to Wednesday afternoon.
