First discussion on European Energy Union strategy

Parliament will discuss the plans for a European Energy Union, a top priority for the current Commission, after they are unveiled in the House on Wednesday afternoon by Maroš Šefčovič, Vice-President for Energy Union. The debate starts at 15.00.

Commissioner Šefčovič highlighted the five key priorities for the Energy Union in a debate with Parliament's Industry, Research and Energy Committee on 26 January:

- Ensuring security of supply for Europe;
- Deeper integration of EU national energy markets;
- Reducing EU energy demand;
- Reducing carbon emissions from the energy sector;
- Promoting research and development in energy.

The committee is currently drafting a non-binding resolution on the European Energy Security Strategy, scheduled for a vote in committee on 7 May 2015 (rapporteur: Algirdas Saudargas EPP, LT).

MEPs will debate the ECB's activities with its President Mario Draghi and Commission Vice-President for the euro Valdis Dombrovskis on Wednesday, starting at about 18.15. Likely issues include completing the Banking Union, recent monetary policy measures (buying up asset-backed securities and quantitative easing), and the ECB's role in the EU Commission/IMF/ECB "troika" and in developments in Greece.

The ECB's annual report for 2013 is assessed in a report, drafted by Pablo Zalba Bidegain (EPP, ES) for Parliament's Economic and Monetary Affairs Committee, which is to be put to a vote by Parliament as a whole at a plenary session in March.

Debate on informal summit outcome and fight against terrorism

The outcome of the 12 February informal summit, where EU leaders urged EU lawmakers to deliver a European Passenger Name Record (PNR) directive with data protection safeguards, will be debated with European Council and Commission presidents Donald Tusk and Jean-Claude Juncker on Wednesday, starting at about 17.00. MEPs are also likely to address the plight of Greece and developments in Ukraine.

At the informal summit, EU heads of state or government urged EU legislators to "urgently adopt a strong and effective European Passenger Name Records [PNR] directive with solid data protection safeguards".

On 26 February, a new draft report on the PNR proposal and a possible timetable for its further discussion and approval will be presented by lead MEP Timothy Kirkhope (ECR, UK) in the Civil Liberties Committee.
