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STATEMENT OF REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE BY SECTION

The statement of revenue and expenditure by section is forwarded separately in all languages via the SEI-BUD system. An English language version is attached as budgetary annex by way of example.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The purpose of this preliminary draft amending budget is to adapt the Commission's section of the 2005 budget to the changes made by the revision of the services' organisation charts in connection with the appointment of the new Commission.

It follows the Commission's decision of 22 December 2004 which translated in concrete form, at the level of the organisational charts of the Commission, the political repartition of the portfolios of the Commissioners within the new Commission.

This reorganisation has however to be taken into account also from the budgetary point of view. The present preliminary draft amending budget thus aims to make the necessary technical modifications to the 2005 budget.

Table 1 under annex 1 gives the modifications to the budgetary nomenclature necessary to take account of the transfer of certain activities from one to another policy area as mentioned above.

Concerning the administrative expenditure, the relevant administrative lines have also to be adjusted according to the modifications to the allocations of human resources between the different policy areas concerned². Table 2 to 8 under annex 1 give the details of the lines concerned.

The net effect of these changes in the budget for 2005 is budgetary neutral.

The modification of the repartition keys used for attributing administrative expenditure, including Amending letters no 1 and 2/2005, has an impact on the administrative expenditure of all policy areas.
