Justification

80% of the US firms have a branch in Canada and will be able to use CETA to sue EU Gvts; the Canadian PM called the new US President to work closely with the new US administration, especially on trade; during the current legislature the EP has issued no resolution at all on CETA; most independent assessment studies warn on the impact of CETA on growth, jobs and on European environmental and social legislations; there is great uncertainty on the status of the additional documents of CETA; Commission has announced it will modify ICS, the EP should not ratify a provisional version of it.
