

on the proposal for a decision of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Decision No 2256/2003/EC in view of the extension of the programme in 2006 for the dissemination of good practices and monitoring ICT take-up (COM(2005)0347-C6-0247/2005-2005/0144(COD))

(Codecision procedure: first reading)

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Commission proposal to the European Parliament and the Council (COM(2005)0347)¹,
- having regard to Article 251(2) and Article 157(3) of the EC Treaty, pursuant to which the Commission submitted the proposal to Parliament (C6-0247/2005),
- having regard to Rules 51 and 43(1) of its Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to the report of the Committee on Industry, Research and Energy (A6-0302/2005),
- 1. Approves the Commission proposal;
- 2. Calls on the Commission to refer the matter to Parliament again if it intends to amend its proposal substantially or replace it with another text;
- 3. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council and Commission.
