*The European Parliament,*

- having regard to the Council position at first reading (10755/1/2016 – C8-0015/2017),
  - having regard to the opinion of European Economic and Social Committee of 16 October 2013<sup>1</sup>,
  - having regard to the opinion of the Committee of the Regions of 29 November 2013<sup>2</sup>,
  - having regard to its position at first reading<sup>3</sup> on the Commission proposal to Parliament and the Council (COM(2013)0265),
  - having regard to Article 294(7) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,
  - having regard to Rule 67a of its Rules of Procedure,
  - having regard to the recommendation for second reading of the Committee on the Environment, Public Health and Food Safety (A8-0022/2017),
1. Approves the Council position at first reading;
  2. Notes that the act is adopted in accordance with the Council position;
  3. Instructs its President to sign the act with the President of the Council, in accordance with Article 297(1) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union;
  4. Instructs its Secretary-General to sign the act, once it has been verified that all the procedures have been duly completed, and, in agreement with the Secretary-General of

the Council, to arrange for its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*;

5. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council, the Commission and the national parliaments.
