# Proposal for a regulation Article 6 – paragraph 3

Text proposed by the Commission

3. In the waters up to 100 nautical miles from the baselines of the *Azores*, *Madeira* and the Canary Islands, the Member States concerned may from 1 January 2013 to 31 December 2022 restrict fishing to vessels registered in the ports of those islands. Such restrictions shall not apply to Union vessels that traditionally fish in those waters, in so far as those vessels do not exceed the fishing effort traditionally exerted. Member States shall inform the Commission of the restrictions put in place under this paragraph.

Amendment

3. In the waters up to 100 nautical miles from the baselines of *all* the *outermost* regions of the Union, and in their fishing grounds and seamounts beyond 100 nautical miles, the Member States concerned may from 1 January 2013 to 31 December 2022 restrict fishing to vessels registered in the ports of those regions. Continued access by Union vessels that can prove that they traditionally fish in those waters shall be conditional on the sustainability of fish stocks. Those vessels may not exceed the fishing effort *that they have* traditionally exerted. Member States shall inform the Commission of the restrictions put in place under this paragraph.
