1. Member States shall ensure that any firearm or *part* placed on the market has been ***marked and registered in compliance with this Directive***

1. ***With respect to the firearms manufactured or imported into the Union after [insert date of referred to in Article 2(1) of this Amending Directive], Member States shall ensure that any firearm or essential component of a firearm has been placed on the market^{1a}.***
