Amendment

4. Payments by beneficiaries shall be supported by invoices and documents proving payment. Where this cannot be done, payments shall be supported by documents of equivalent probative value, except for forms of support under Article 57(1)(b), (c) and (d) of Regulation (EU) [CSF/2012].

4. Except in duly justified cases, non repayable direct assistance shall be in the forms provided for in Article 57(1) (b), (c) and (d) of Regulation (EU) [CSF/2012]. Where such assistance is provided in the form provided for in Article 57(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) [CSF/2012] payments by beneficiaries shall be supported by invoices and documents proving payment. Where this cannot be done, payment shall be supported by documents of equivalent probative value.

Article 69 – paragraph 1

Text proposed by the Commission

Amendment

1. Member States shall ensure that all the rural development measures they intend to implement are verifiable and controllable. To this end the Managing Authority and the paying agency of each rural development programme shall provide an ex ante assessment of the verifiability and controllability of the measures to be included in the rural development programme. The Managing Authority and paying agency shall also undertake the assessment of verifiability and controllability of measures during the implementation of the rural development programme. Ex ante assessment and assessment during the implementation period shall take into account the results of controls in the previous and current programming period. Where the assessment reveals that the requirements of verifiability **and controllability** are not met, the measures concerned shall be adjusted accordingly.

1. Member States shall ensure that all the rural development measures they intend to implement are verifiable, and controllable **and designed in a way that does not create undue risk of error**. To this end the Managing Authority and the paying agency of each rural development programme shall provide an ex ante assessment of the verifiability, and controllability **and error risk** of the measures to be included in the rural development programme. The Managing Authority and paying agency shall also undertake the assessment of verifiability, and controllability **and error risk** of measures during the implementation of the rural development programme. Ex ante assessment and assessment during the implementation period shall take into account the results of controls in the previous and current programming period.

Where the assessment reveals that the requirements of verifiability, **and controllability and not creating undue risk of error** are not met, the measures concerned shall be adjusted accordingly.
