### **(Consent)**

*The European Parliament,*

- having regard to the draft Council decision (13613/2013),
  - having regard to the Association Agreement between the European Union and the European Atomic Energy Community and their Member States, of the one part, and Ukraine, of the other part<sup>1</sup>,
  - having regard to the request for consent submitted by the Council in accordance with Article 217 and Articles 218(6), second subparagraph, point (a) and 218(8) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,
  - having regard to its resolution of 1 December 2011 containing the European Parliament's recommendations to the Council, the Commission and the EEAS on the negotiations of the EU-Ukraine Association Agreement<sup>2</sup>,
  - having regard to its resolutions of 12 December 2013<sup>3</sup>, 6 February 2014<sup>4</sup>, 27 February 2014<sup>5</sup>, 13 March 2014<sup>6</sup>, 17 April 2014<sup>7</sup>, 17 July 2014<sup>8</sup>,
  - having regard to Rule 99(1), first and third subparagraphs, Rule 99(2), and Rule 108(7) of its Rules of Procedure,
  - having regard to the recommendation of the Committee on Foreign Affairs(A8-0000/2014),
1. Gives its consent to conclusion of the agreement;
  2. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council, the Commission and the governments and parliaments of the Member States and of Ukraine.
