Alexander Lambsdorff also signed Amendment 23 on behalf of the ALDE Group.

Alexander Lambsdorff moved an oral amendment to § 11, which now read as follows:

- ‘11. Urges the Turkish government to launch, as a matter of priority, a political initiative favouring a lasting settlement of the Kurdish issue, which can only be based on tangible improvements in the cultural, economic and social opportunities available to citizens of Kurdish origin, including real possibilities to learn Kurdish within the public and private schooling system and to use it in broadcasting, in daily life and in access to public services; regards a possible banning of the Democratic Society Party (DTP) as counterproductive to a political solution;’

Ria Oomen-Ruijten moved an oral amendment to § 19, which now read as follows:

- ‘19. Urges the Turkish Constitutional Court to make progress in proceeding to its final decision on the Law on the Ombudsman, so as to enable the government to establish the ombudsman’s office without delay; recommends to Turkey that it should cooperate on this issue with the European Ombudsman and with national ombudsmen in EU Member States;’
