### **PROCEDURAL PAGE**

By letter of 12 March 2003 the Council consulted Parliament, pursuant to Articles 170, first sentence of the first subparagraph of Article 300 (2) and first subparagraph of Article 300 (3) of the EC Treaty, on the proposal for a Council decision on concerning the conclusion of an Agreement aimed at renewing the Agreement on cooperation in science and technology between the European Community and the Government of the Russian Federation (COM(2003) 95 – 2003/0041(CNS)).

At the sitting of 27 March 2003 the President of Parliament announced that he had referred the proposal to the Committee on Industry, External Trade, Research and Energy as the committee responsible and the Committee on Foreign Affairs, Human Rights, Common Security and Defence Policy for its opinion (C5-0106/2003).

At its meeting of 30 April 2003 the Committee on Industry, External Trade, Research and Energy decided, on a proposal from the chairman, to apply the simplified procedure under Rule 158(1), and the chairman was thus appointed rapporteur.

The Committee on Foreign Affairs, Human Rights, Common Security and Defence Policy decided on 25 March 2003 not to deliver an opinion.

## DRAFT EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION

on the proposal for a Council decision on concerning the conclusion of an Agreement aimed at renewing the Agreement on cooperation in science and technology between the European Community and the Government of the Russian Federation (COM(2003) 95 – C5-0106/2003 – 2003/0041(CNS))

## (Consultation procedure)

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Commission proposal to the Council  $(COM(2003) 95)^1$ ,
- having regard to Articles 170, first sentence of the first subparagraph of Article 300 (2) and first subparagraph of Article 300 (3) of the EC Treaty, pursuant to which the Council consulted Parliament (C5-0106/2003),
- having regard to Rule 67 and 158(1) of its Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to the report of the Committee on Industry, External Trade, Research and Energy (A5-0155/2003),
- 1. Approves the Commission proposal;
- 2. Calls on the Council to notify Parliament if it intends to depart from the text approved by Parliament;
- 3. Asks the Council to consult Parliament again if it intends to amend the Commission proposal substantially;
- 4. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council and Commission.
