How to get there

Walking



The Tun is located at the bottom of Holyrood Road, just a few blocks before The Scottish Parliament and Our Dynamic Earth museum. It is an approximate 15 minute walk from the city centre and from Waverley Train Station.

Walking down the Royal Mile (towards the Queen's Gallery), turn right on Jackson's Entry and you will find The Tun on your left, next to Hemma Bar and in front of Pizza Express.

Cycling

Bus



Within Edinburgh, you can take the local Lothian Buses No. 35 or 6 (bus stop in the Royal Mile, two minutes walk from The Tun). You can check the best bus route here: www.lothianbuses.co.uk

Train



The Tun is around a fifteen-minute walk or a five-minute taxi journey from Waverley Train Station.

Car



There is public parking opposite the office below Our Dynamic Earth (please note that parking access for wheelchair users is limited to when the building itself is open. Call 0131 550 7800 or see www.dynamicearth.co.uk for opening times, which change throughout the year - 6 parking bays are reserved for vehicles with disabled passes).



Also on Holyrood Road there is another carpark, St John's Hill NCP (Tel: 0131 556 7886) Carpark is open 24 hours a day and there are 4 parking bays reserved for vehicles with disabled passes.
