### **RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE**

Delivered on the 6<sup>th</sup> session held on 25<sup>th</sup> January 2023

**on the Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on adapting non-contractual civil liability rules to artificial intelligence (AI Liability Directive) /Senate Print no. N 213/13, COM(2022) 496/**

#### **The Senate**

#### **I.**

##### **1. Supports**

the position of the Government of the Czech Republic;

##### **2. Agrees, in particular,**

with the opinion that the proposed rules must be harmonised with already existing rules, should not cause problems of interpretation and application and, while strengthening the position of potential victims, should not disproportionately deviate the balance of the law to the disadvantage of AI systems developers or users;

#### **II.**

##### **1. Requests**

the Government to inform the Senate no later than on 31<sup>st</sup> May 2023 about the way this Resolution was taken into account and about the further development of negotiations;

##### **2. Authorises**

the President of the Senate to forward this Resolution to the European Commission.
