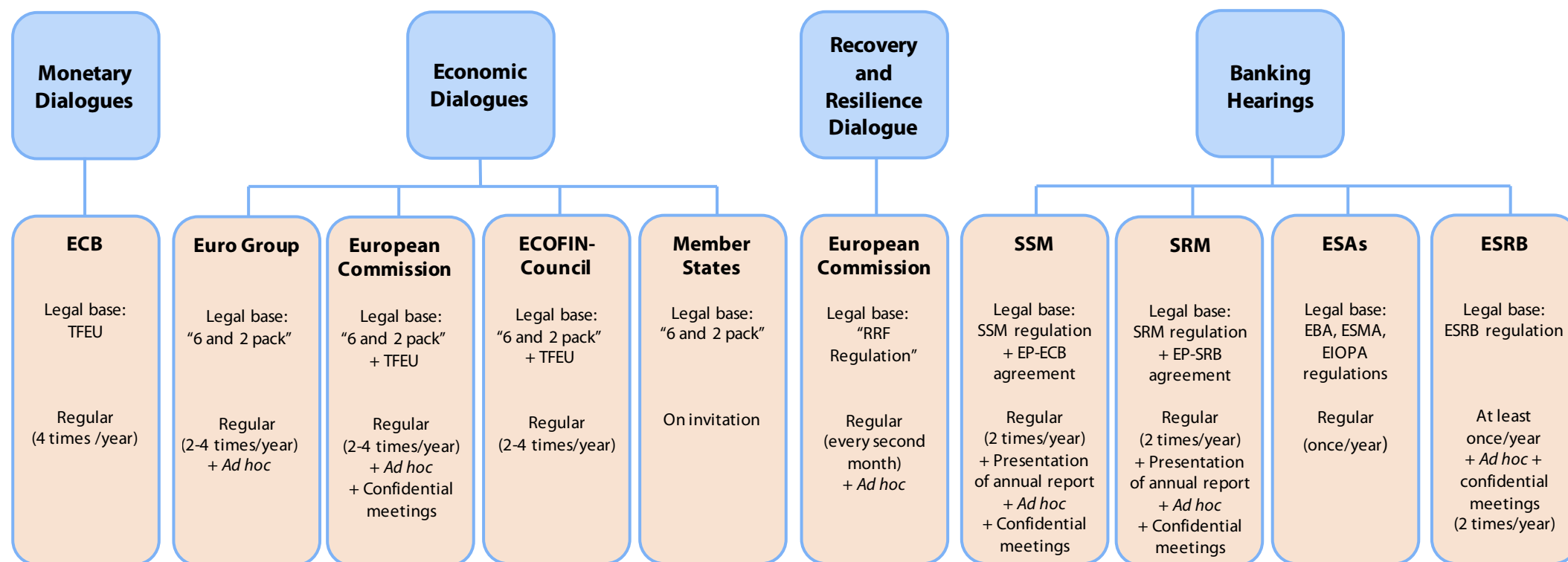


Scrutiny dialogues and hearings in the European Parliament in the area of monetary, economic and financial affairs



In addition, ad hoc hearings may be organised by the competent committee with the Managing Director of the ESM, the Director-General of Eurostat and the President of the EIB. Meetings with national parliaments on the implementation of the European Semester for economic policy coordination, including the Recovery and Recovery Facility, are also organised on a regular basis.
