

**Priority question for written answer P-004154/2020
to the Commission**

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Subject: Transposition of Directive (EU) 2018/957 into national law

Directive (EU) 2018/957 must be transposed into national law by 30 July 2020. From then on, it will be mandatory to apply all the provisions regarding remuneration in the host country that are contained in national legislation or in collective agreements declared to be generally binding. To this end, Member States should publish information on working and employment conditions, including information relating to wages.

As transparency and access to information are of central importance for planning and preparing postings that take place after 30 July 2020, the information must be made available as soon as possible.

1. Does the Commission know which Member States have already updated the single official national website required by the Directive with the necessary information or at least intend to do so before 30 July 2020?
2. Does the Commission have an overview of which Member States intend to publish the information regarding the additional work and employment conditions applicable to postings of more than 12 or 18 months in accordance with the above Directive in a clear and transparent manner before 30 July 2020?
3. What measures does the Commission intend to take to ensure that the information is available on the various national websites in a comparable form and quality and in the main official EU languages?
