Mr. Cupei was the initiator and founder of the European Forum of Deposit Insurers (EFDI). He has been Vice Chairman of EFDI since 2005, Chairman of EFDI since 2014 and also Chairman of the EFDI Investor Compensation Working Group.

At the same time, as a Managing Director at the Association of German Banks, he is responsible for the "Einlagensicherungsfonds deutscher Banken", the German private banks' voluntary deposit protection scheme. Furthermore, he is Managing Director of the "Entschädigungseinrichtung deutscher Banken GmbH" (EdB), the mandatory deposit protection and investor compensation scheme for private banks in Germany as well as of "Koch, Lauteren GmbH". Additionally he is also Member of the Board of the "Liquiditäts-Konsortialbank GmbH i.L."

He represents the Association of German Banks in different German, European and international organisations and chairs the Deposit Guarantee Schemes Working Group at the European Banking Federation (EBF).

In addition, he acts as an expert and consultant to a number of German, European and international institutions and is a member of various bank creditors' committees.

Mr. Cupei graduated from the Rhenish Friedrich-Wilhelms University, Bonn and the Westphalian Wilhelms-University, Münster. He is a qualified lawyer, specialising in business and banking law.
