# Work in progress

### CAP tools to reduce price volatility in agricultural markets

Angélique Delahaye (EPP, FR) will present her draft own-initiative report on CAP tools to reduce price volatility in agricultural markets. Among other proposals, the rapporteur asks the Commission to facilitate the introduction of contractual systems by adapting competition law, to improve the tools for risk management and to implement a European agricultural price observatory for various agricultural sectors.

#### Revision of the MFF 2014-2020: Parliament's input ahead of the Commission's proposal



Peter Jahr (EPP, DE) has prepared an opinion for the AGRI Committee on the post-election revision of the multi-annaual financing framework (MFF) for 2014-2020. The opinion highlights the demands of the AGRI Committee on the agricultural budget (Heading 2). In total 131 amendments have been tabled and the rapporteur negotiated 7 compromises with the shadow rapporteurs for the political groups.

#### **EU 2017 Budget - EP Mandate for the Trilogue**



In total 48 amendments have been tabled to the draft AGRI opinion by Peter Jahr (EPP, DE) in view of the EP mandate for the trilogue on the 2017 budget to be prepared by BUDG, the Committee on Budget. The draftsman has proposed 6 compromises with a view to ease the vote.

#### A new forward-looking and innovative future strategy on trade and investment



135 amendments have been tabled to the draft opinion by Esther Herranz García (EPP, ES) on the "Trade for all" Communication by the European Commission. The rapporteur has negotiated 6 compromise amendments. This draft opinion will feed into the report by INTA, the Committee on International Trade.
