Experiences so far

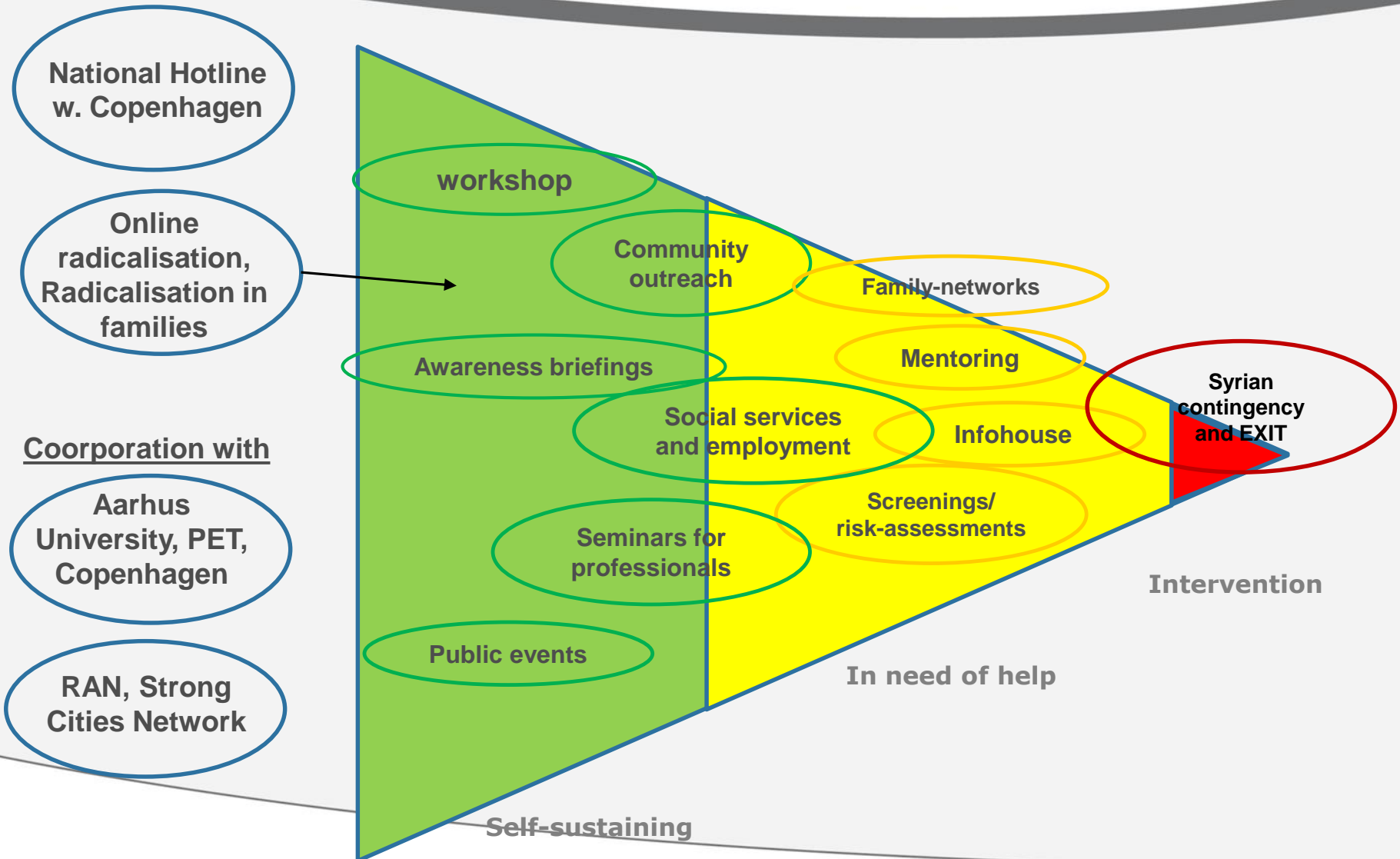
- Approx. 400 reports in last four years. (15-25 years old)
- Primarily Islamist and right-wing radicalisation (2 instances of left-wing)
- Most cases have been dealt with through counselling
- 28 persons have so far been attached to the mentor program
- 9 persons currently being mentored

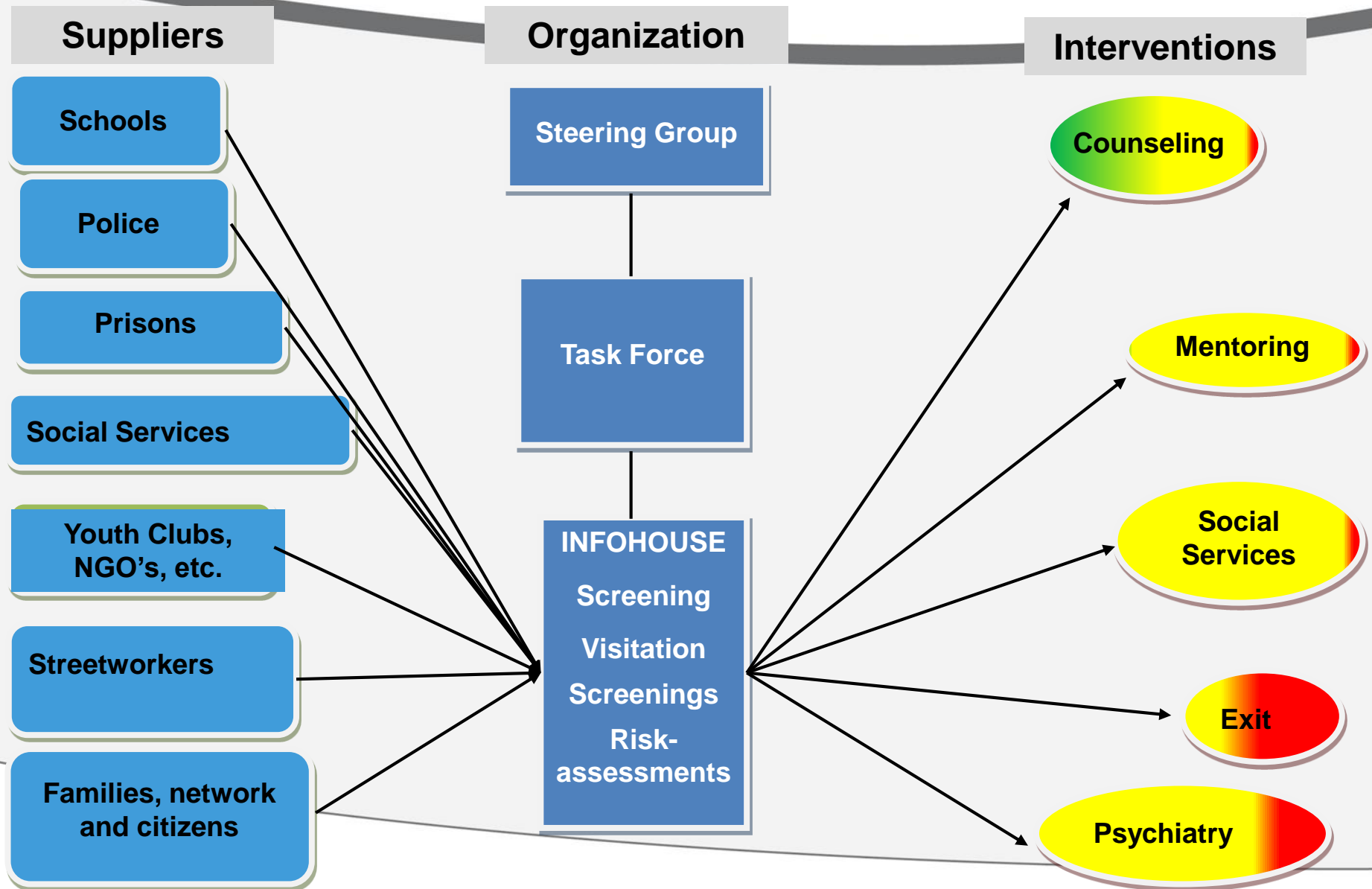


Syrian volunteers (Syria/Iraq) The Situation in Aarhus

- 36 persons from December 2012 until now
- 8 reported killed
- 18 returned
- 10 still in Syria/Iraque (presumed)
- Danish Citizens with various ethnic backgrounds: Somali, Turkish, Palestinian, Jordanian, Sudanese, Danish, mixed ethnicity.
- 4 converts
