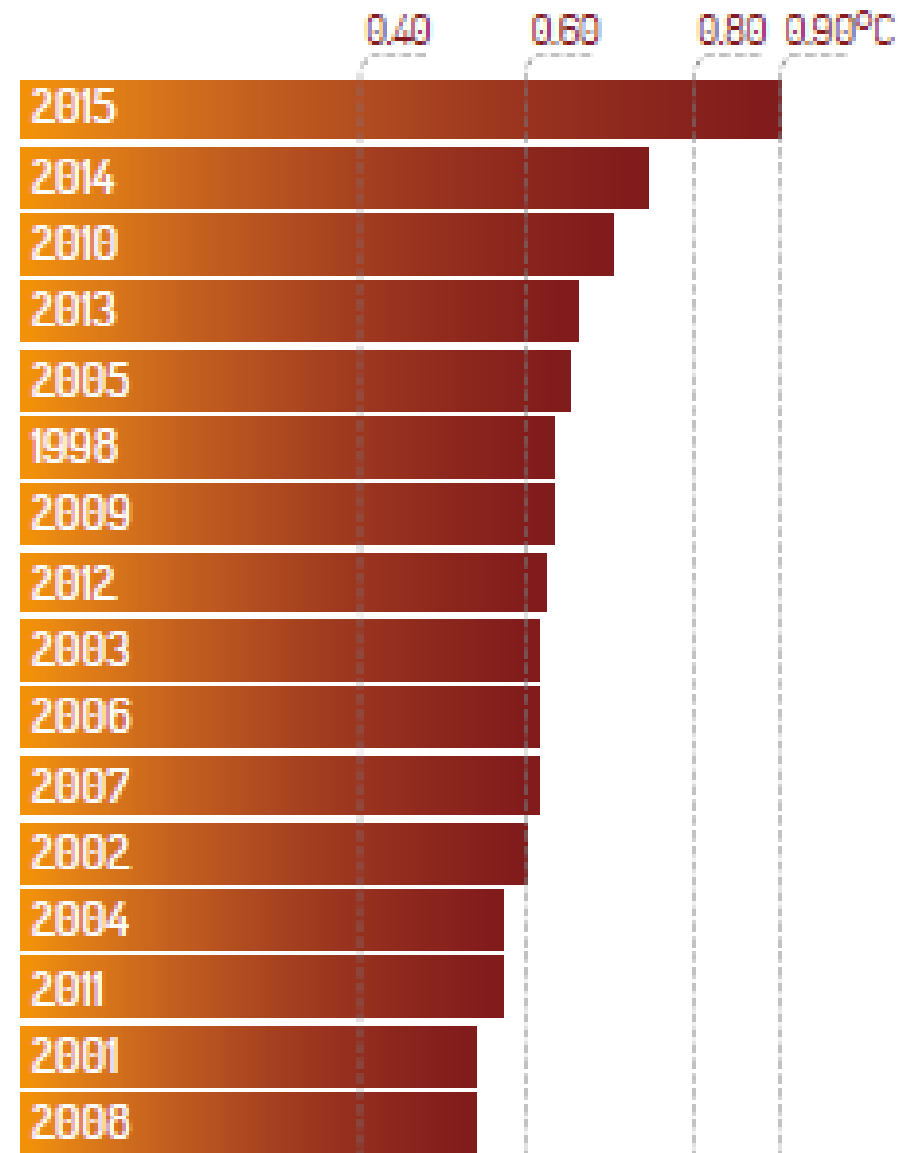
The Paris Agreement 1.5C objective:

Key messages

1. Need a more ambitious target: 'no debit' not compatible with the Paris Agreement

 - account for bioenergy emissions

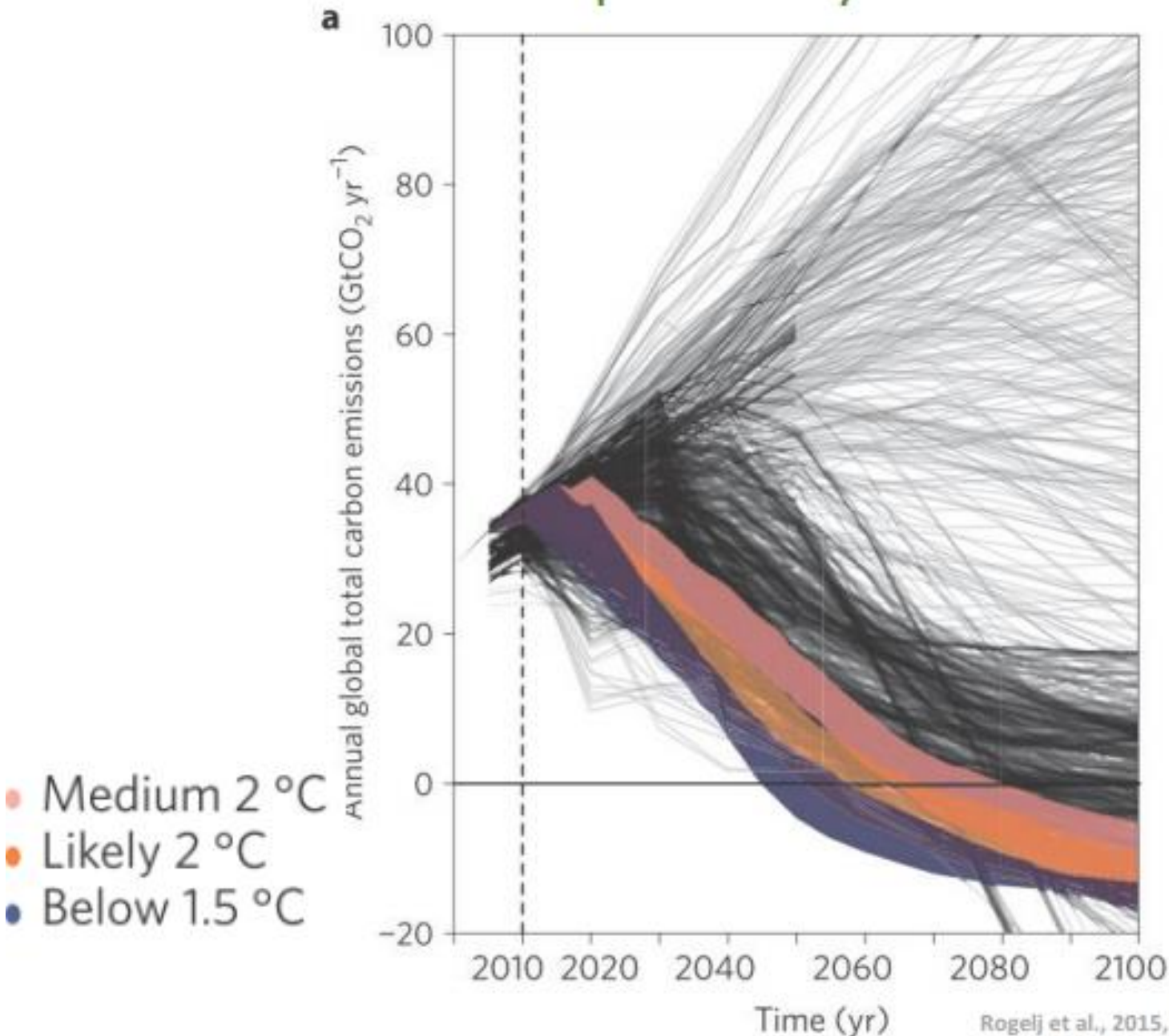

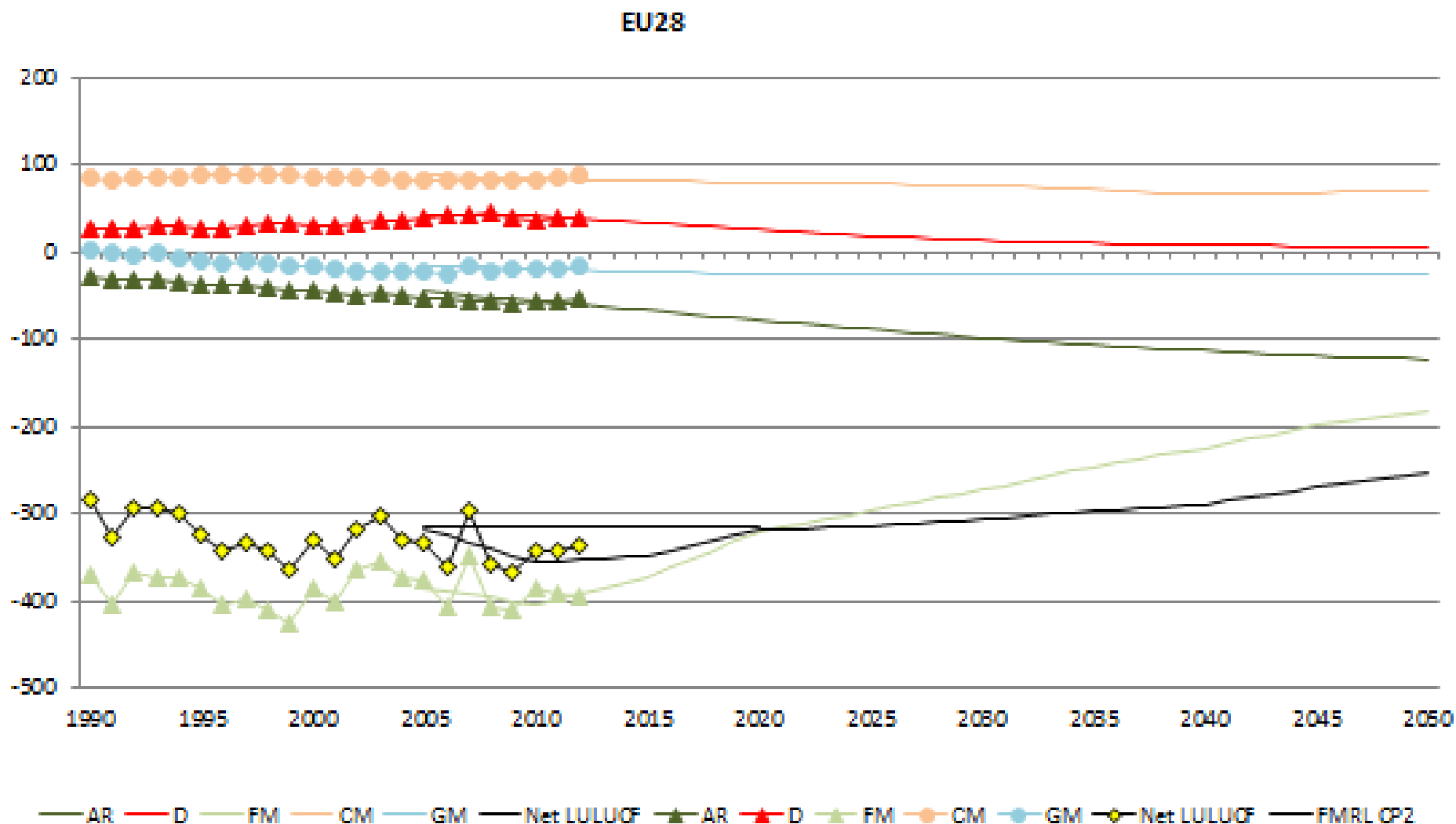

The United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change says:

“The ultimate objective of the Convention is to stabilize greenhouse gas concentrations "at a level that would prevent dangerous anthropogenic (human induced) interference with the climate system.”
