

#### Purpose of the landing obligation

- Increase selectivity
  - Gear technology
  - Move on / Real Time Closures

- The obvious problem
  - Can inevitable discarding be accepted by society
  - How to manage mixed fisheries

#### The Sole and other Flats dilemma

- To catch Sole mesh size < 80mm</li>
- Escape other Flats mesh size > 120 mm



## Resulting in mixed catches per haul per trip per location per season

#### Re-think the phasing in process

- A Big Bang in 2019 can no longer be avoided:
  - a deadly blow to our flatfish fisheries
  - choking fisheries closure in april-june 2019
- European Parliament recent message
  - Control delay only
  - No solution for the underlying problems

#### Re-think the phasing in process

- · Discarding is not a criminal act in itself
  - Nor is breeding chicken or goats
  - Do not ask for the impossible
    - Make it workable or buy a supplychain out!

#### How to continue?

- By gathering in depth data
  - Joint science/industry programmes
- By steering north Sea plan far away from Baltic plan

#### How to continue?

- By adapting the time schedule
  - Leaving basic principles for art 15 intact
- Change implementation schedule
  - Incentivise avoidance via a new timeline
  - encourage innovation via this new timeline
  - stimulate selectivity via a realistic timeline

#### **Adaptive management**

- Adapt the regime -1-
  - aim for real **mixed** fisheries plans (56 species in the mix)
    - discards are inevitable and no crime
    - no single species plans "connected via a treasury tag"
    - be bold and act on <100 % certainty</li>
    - get real fishers on board as ambassadors

#### **Adaptive management**

- Adapt the regime -2-
  - Incentivise
    - Safe biological limits as a pre-requisite
    - Improve survival
      - Combined with responsible survival exemptions
    - North Sea Wide applied gear technology
      - Pre and post Brexit include Norway
    - Out of the box innovation
      - Pre and post Brexit include Norway
