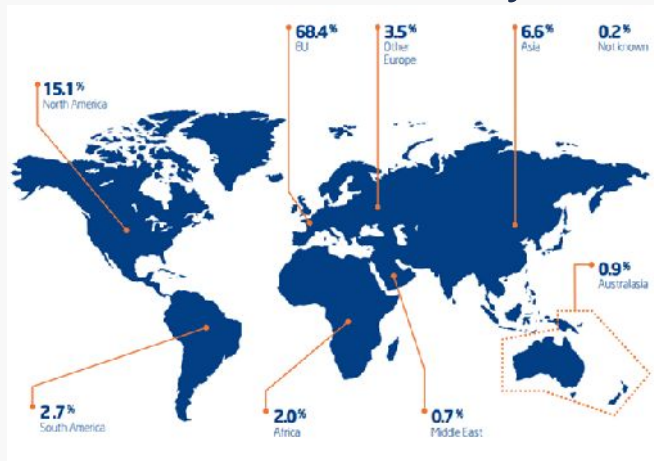


IMPLICATIONS OF BREXIT FOR EDUCATION

UK Student Mobility



In 14/15 only 7.2% of UK students were mobile.

In 2015/16, 9,836 UK students studied abroad on Erasmus+ and 6,608 UK students worked abroad on Erasmus+

UK hosted 30,183 students under the Erasmus+ scheme.

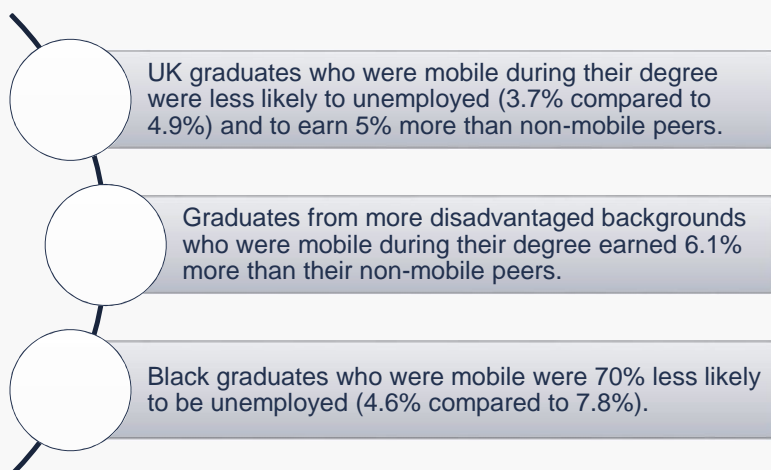
