

'Clean energy for all Europeans' – EU electricity market

July 2017

The Commission presented a legislative package on 30 November 2016, which aims at a general overhaul of EU energy legislation in order to bring it into line with the EU 2030 energy and climate policy framework. It consists of a communication on 'Clean energy for all Europeans', eight legislative proposals, a report on energy prices and costs, an ecodesign workplan and implementing legislation, as well as communications on energy funding, innovation and transport. EPRS has prepared 'EU Legislation in Progress' briefings for each of the legislative proposals in the package, initial implementation appraisals, as well as a number of briefings and in-depth analyses on some of the key issues addressed in the package.

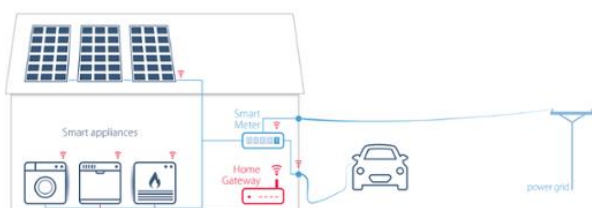

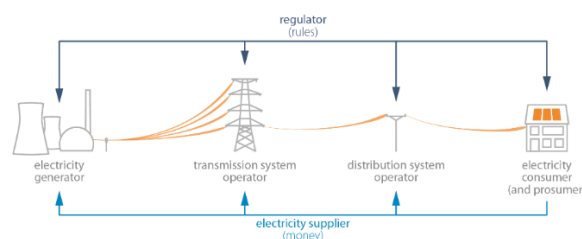
