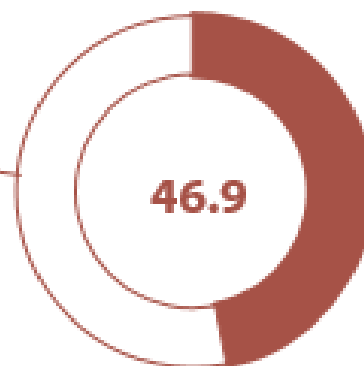

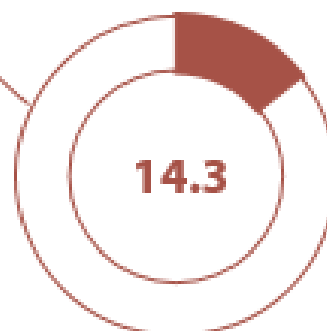

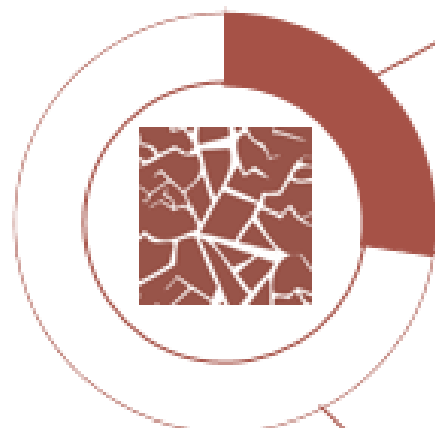

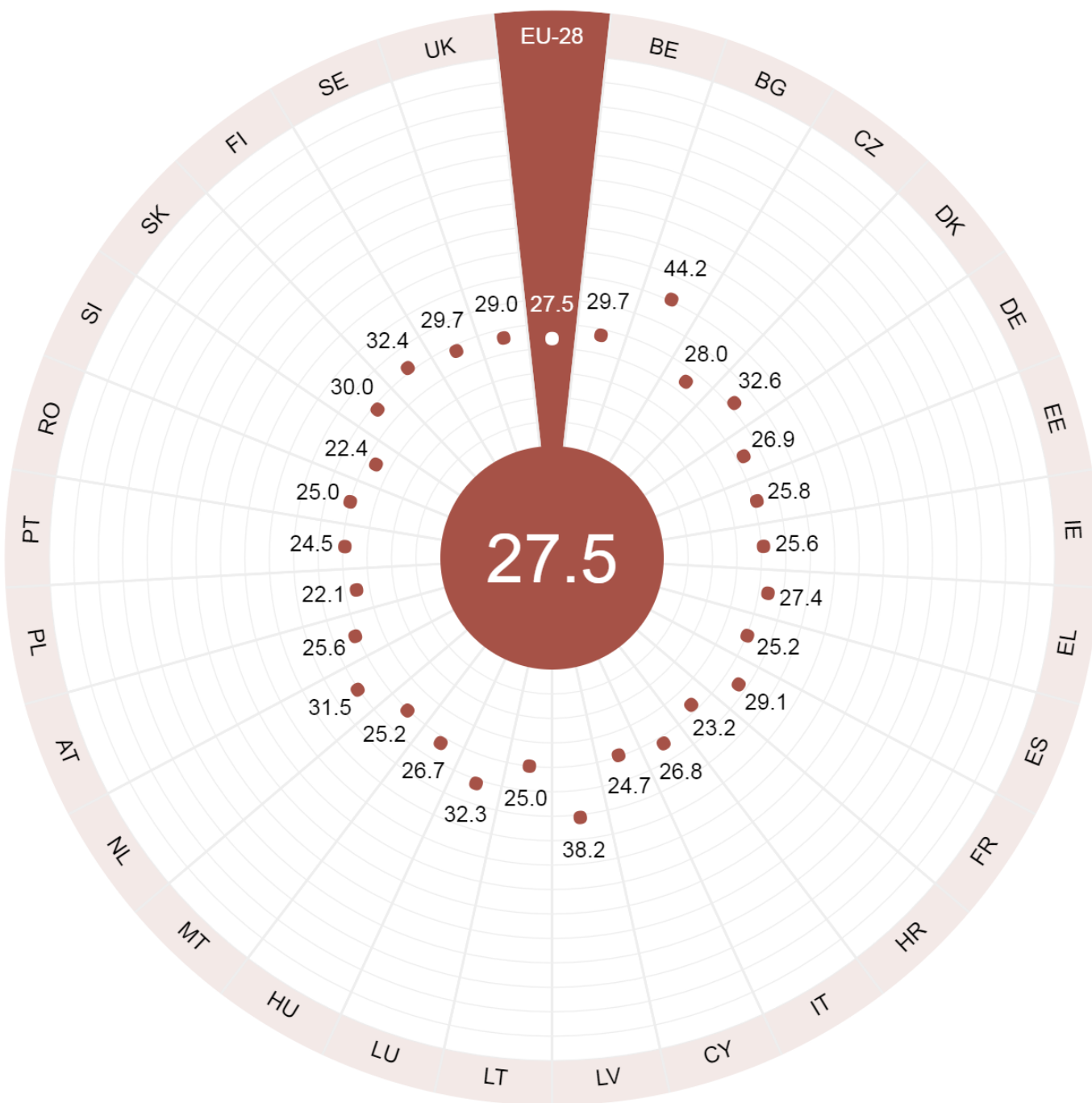


Disclosure of violence experienced in the past 12 months
