Dear colleagues,

First of all, allow me to extend my sincere best wishes for the new year to you and your loved ones.

As the last 'full year' of the current legislature, 2018 promises to be very busy for the European Parliament, and more particularly for the ITRE committee, as we are determined to conclude several important pieces of legislation before the end of term.

During its first January meeting, ITRE will continue to work on the European Defence Industrial Development Programme. Over four hundred amendments have been tabled to the rapporteur's proposal. These amendments will now be discussed among the Committee members with a view to facilitating compromises. We will also consider two draft reports: one on the Common rules for the internal market in natural gas and the other on the European One Health Action Plan against Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR), for which ITRE is preparing an opinion.

Finally, the Committee will vote on three draft reports, namely the own initiative report on 'Accelerating Clean Energy Innovation', the agreement for scientific and Establishing the European Defence Industrial Development Programme aiming at supporting the competitiveness and innovative capacity of the EU defence industry

Consideration of amendments

ITRE Members have tabled more than 430 amendments to the Commission proposal on the European Defence Industrial Development Programme, in addition to those included in the rapporteur's draft report. The amendments cover most of the issues addressed in the Commission proposal, and in particular the objectives, the sources of the budget, the eligible actions and entities, the award criteria and the funding rates.

Common rules for the internal market in natural gas

Consideration of draft report

Rapporteur: Jerzy Buzek

The rapporteur will present his draft report on a Commission proposal to amend Directive 2009 /73/EC concerning common rules for the internal market in natural gas. The Commission proposal extends the scope of application of the Directive to pipelines to and from third countries, including existing and future pipelines, up to the border of EU 'jurisdiction'. The rapporteur welcomes the proposal but puts forward a number of amendments which aim to complement and further strengthen some of the provisions. Among them is a clarification of the Directive's scope, stricter conditions and a maximum time limit for derogations and a shortened deadline for the transposition of the Directive.

The ITRE rapporteur, Ms Wierinck (ALDE), will present her draft opinion to the ENVI own-initiative report on One Health Action Plan against Antimicrobial Resistance. The fight against antimicrobial resistance is one of the challenges of the Horizon 2020 Framework programme on Research and Innovation. The rapporteur in particular states that AMR-related challenges will increase in the years ahead and effective action is reliant on continued, cross-sectoral investments in research & innovation (R&I), so that better tools, products and approaches can be developed following a 'One Health' approach. In this sense, she formulates several concrete actions to be taken.
