The 2016 discharge of the "Other institutions" - European External Action Service is prepared by the Rapporteur Marco Valli.

The European External Action Service (EEAS) is a functionally autonomous body of the European Union, separate from the General Secretariat of the Council and from the Commission. It is treated as an institution for the purposes of the Financial Regulation (FR) and therefore subject to the procedure of discharge provided for in Article 319 of the TFEU and in Article 167 of the Financial Regulation.

It is placed under the authority of the High Representative / Vice-President (HRVP) of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy who is invited to the CONT meeting for an exchange of views with Members on the implementation of EEAS budget and activities during the financial year 2016.

In accordance with the timetable for the discharge procedure, the written questions addressed to the EEAS were sent on 15/11/2017. The answers received from the EEAS were e-mailed to the CONT Members on 20/12/201 and are available on the CONT website.

According to the findings of the ECA, the most likely error rate was 0.2% and the main area for improvement, as in 2015, concerns the procurement procedures organized by EU delegations.

It is proposed that the exchange of views shall proceed as follows:

- introduction by the Member of the European Court of Auditors, Mr Pietro Russo, who will present the findings of the ECA Annual Report 2016;
- High Representative/Vice-President Federica Mogherini will briefly reply to this introduction and present the EEAS's achievements:
- the CONT Rapporteur Marco Valli and other Members will question the HR/VP and/or the Court;
- closing remarks by the CONT Rapporteur.
